Dr. Julian will present an overview of implant applications, surgical kit components, delivery systems, drilling into bone, pre and post operative considerations, anatomy, aseptic technique, surgical protocol of implant placement, different implants and systems, soft tissue surgery, incision, flap design, flap elevation and suturing, multi-implant placement, use of surgical templates and paralleling devices. Second stage surgery, progressive loading, documentation and consent forms and immediate post extraction placement will also be covered. Prosthetic stages and steps to restore the integrated implant will also be discussed. Dr. Julian will overview the available imaging systems for the implant dentist and the necessary imaging for different types of cases. Dr. Julian will discuss the use, the role and the indications of lasers in implant dentistry. Dr. Julian will stimulate the attendees to think critically about whatever role they play in delivering implants to their patients.

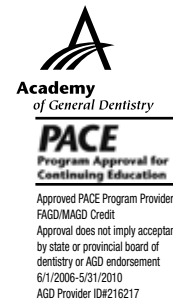
